#### Our Science project this half term is... Our Bodies

We will be learning to identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body. We will be investigating our five senses and thinking about which body parts those senses link to. We will be sorting and classifying animals into groups according to common features. We will identify which animals are mammals, fish, amphibians, birds and reptiles.


#### Our Humanities project this half term is...

Year 1/2 First Half Autumn Term 2023



We will be discussing the physical and human features of the school and its grounds and sorting these features into the correct category. We will be designing symbols to represent features of the school grounds and following a simple route to explore some of the physical and human features of our school. We will then design our own maps of the school.

#### **English**



We will be focussing most of our learning this half term on the story 'Beegu' by Alexis Deacon. The children will be thinking about sentence structure with year one writing simple sentences, using a capital letter, finger spaces and full stops. Year 2 will be using conjunctions and adjectives to make their writing more exciting.

#### Maths

In Maths, we will be focussing to begin with on Place Value. In Year 1, this is sorting objects, counting objects, recognising numbers as words, finding 1 more/1 less than a number and comparing numbers. Year 2 will be counting objects to 100, recognising tens and ones and partitioning numbers to 100. We will be counting in 2's, 5's, 10's and starting to count in 3's.



We have 2 PE lessons each week as well as computing and we study an RE unit on our RE day. Our music this term is learning songs about the body and the senses, using body percussion and composing our own lyrics.



#### ART

As we move into <u>Autumn</u> we will be exploring the changing colours in <u>our</u> environment. We will make mood boards of the colours we can see and make close observational paintings of Autumn leaves.

#### Reading

Last year we asked you to help us develop RfP and to help your child enjoy reading and we would like you to continue this.



All staff are invested in this and we cannot stress enough how important this is.


