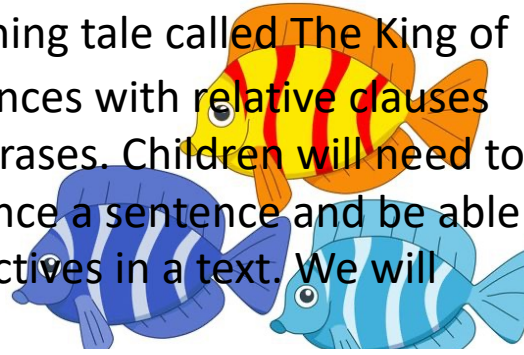


In English we will be learning a wishing tale called The King of Fishes. We will learn to write list sentences with relative clauses and begin sentences with adverbial phrases. Children will need to be able to explain what makes a sentence a sentence and be able to find verbs, adverbs, nouns and adjectives in a text. We will also be focusing on handwriting.



In P.E. the children will be taking part in dance and putting movements together to make a sequence.

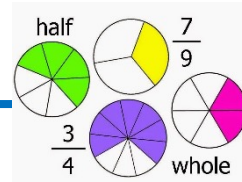


In Humanities we will be completing the first half of this term's project on Norwich. Our main focus will be geographical as we look at the human and physical geography of the city and its surrounds. This will include transport links, amenities and facilities and economy. The children will be using maps and plans to plan a route around the city.



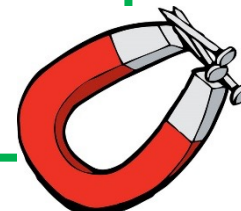
In Maths we will be

- ordering, reading and writing numbers up to 10,000.
- Finding fractions of a shape and an amount and recognising equivalent fractions
- Counting forwards and backwards in tenths and hundreds
- Dividing and multiplying numbers by 10 and 100 (including going into decimals)
- Practising recall of multiplication and division facts



Year 3&4 Spring 1 overview

In Science we will be learning about forces and magnets. Children will learn that a force is a push or a pull. They will use force meters to conduct experiments. They will learn about magnets, their uses and conduct experiments using them.



In Art we will look at the work of Ney Cardoso and his paintings 'faces in blue', 'faces in red' and 'faces in orange'. Children will explore warm and cold colour palettes, creating mood boards in their sketchbooks. From this, children will use collage techniques to create portraits in different moods.
