Our main text for this half term will be Marcy and the Riddle of the Sphinx.

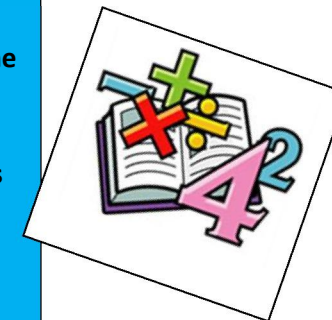
We will be describing a setting, writing the information text for our pop up books and an Egyptian portal story.

Maths

In Maths, we are covering work in many areas of the maths curriculum however we will have a strong focus on place value. We will be supporting the children in developing quick recall of number facts particularly times tables. We will also be learning developing our written skills in addition and subtraction.



We have 2 PE lessons each week , on a Tuesday and a Wednesday, and we will be focussing on OAA and fitness. In music children will learn how to play the violin.

In French the children will be learning greetings; how to say hello and introduce themselves.



In art we will be printing and this will be linked to the topic of Ancient Egypt and hieroglyphics.

In DT we will be making pop up books to enhance our English information texts about based around the Egyptian gods.
