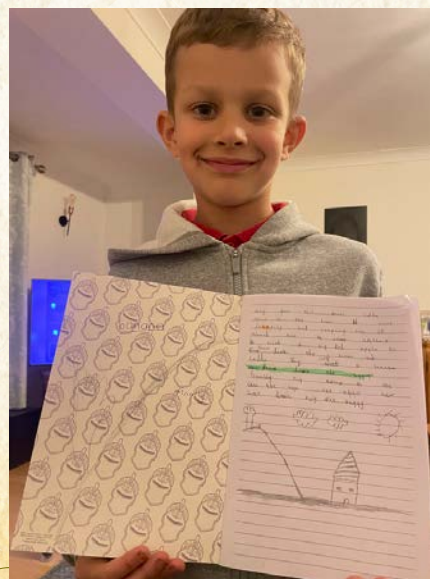
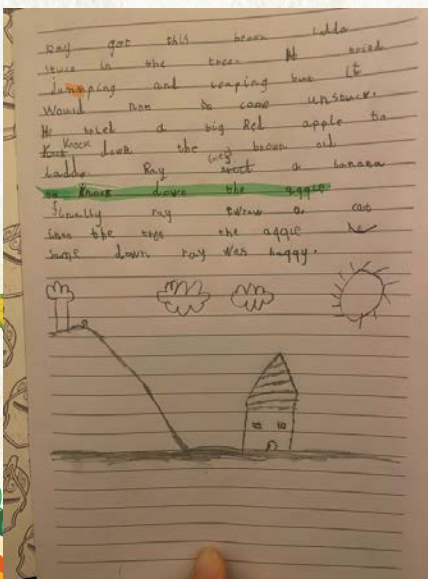

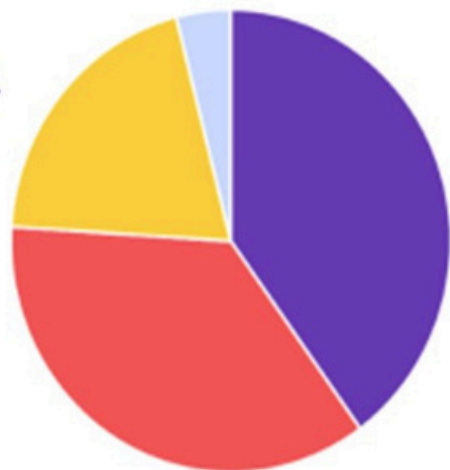
How it works...
